Honourable President,

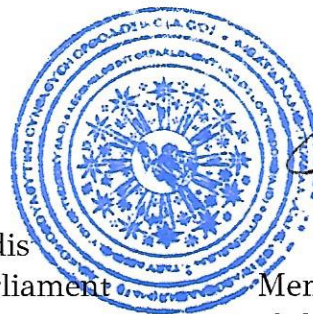
