



R E S O L U T I O N

**of the Secretariat of the European Interparliamentary
Assembly on Orthodoxy**

The Secretariat of the European Interparliamentary Assembly on Orthodoxy, consisting of members of Parliaments of Greece, Russia, Bulgaria, Romania, Ukraine, Armenia and Latvia, expresses its deep concern over the recent events that took place on the islets Imia of the Aegean which, according to the International agreements constitute part of the Hellenic territory.

The Secretariat condemns the Turkish actions which almost lead to warfare between Greece and Turkey.

The Secretariat of the European International Assembly on Orthodoxy, which, on the grounds of its founding principles is committed towards contributing in the safeguarding of peace, sides with the content of the Resolution of the European Parliament, which emphasizes that the national borders of its member-states also constitutes European borders.

The European Interparliamentary Assembly on Orthodoxy consists of the Parliaments of Russia, Bulgaria, Romania, Ukraine, Armenia, Latvia, Slovakia, Belarus, Esthonia, Finland, Georgia, Lithuania, Moldova, Poland, Serbia, Cyprus and Greece.
